

Fee Schedule 2020

1. Overview

This Fee Schedule outlines tuition fees for higher education at the Australian Performing Arts Conservatory (APAC), and other charges related to studying at the Conservatory. All fees referred to in this schedule are in Australian Dollars, unless otherwise specified. Payment of fees is outlined in the *Fees Policy*. Tuition fees may be refundable in certain circumstances. 3. Tuition Fees

Bachelor Screen and Stage (BSS) courses

6. Definitions

Census Date: The official date the financial liability for courses is set and tuition fee is due for domestic students. Census dates are determined for each term and are published on the Conservatory's website.

Credit transfer is a process that provides students with agreed and consistent credit outcomes for components of a qualification based on identified equivalence in content and learning outcomes between matched qualifications (Australian Qualifications Framework definition).

Domestic Student: An Australian Citizen, Australian Permanent Resident or a New Zealand Citizen.

Due Date: The deadline for payment of fees as shown on the invoice for students, and also listed in the *Letter of Offer* and *Written Agreement*.

Full-time Study Load: Standard full-time study load for a particular course.

Recognition of prior learning (RPL) is a process used to assess an individual's relevant prior learning (including formal, informal and non-formal learning) to determine the credit that may be granted towards completion of a qualification (adapted from Australian Qualifications Framework definition).
