Assessable qualifications are considered to be:

- senior secondary studies equivalent to the NSW HSC
- one full year of Australian or comparable tertiary studies, including associate diploma and advanced diploma, associate degree, bachelor's degree and postgraduate studies
- comparable AQF diploma and advanced diploma
- Australian or comparable non-award studies and tertiary preparation courses, with a full-time equivalence of one year.

If you do not have an assessable qualification from one of the above countries, but have successfully completed no less than the equivalent of one-year full-time study of a recognised, government-accredited, public or private secondary/post-secondary course that is taught in English equivalent to the level of Australian Year 12 or higher, you can satisfy the APAC language requirement by providing an official document from your institution on the institution letterhead certifying that the medium of instruction for your.
