Hong Kong	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) with a minimum aggregate score of 15 over the best 5 subjects (across Core and category A or C electives), with a minimum grade requirement of 2 in each subject.
India	<p>Year 12 in one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All India Senior School Certificate (CBSE) with an average of at least 60% Indian School Certificate (ISCE) with an average of at least 60% Indian Higher Secondary School Certificate (State Board) with an average of at least 60% Certificate of Vocational Education with an average of at least 70%
Indonesia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sekolah Menengah Atas (SMA) 3 with a minimum average score of 70% in the best 5 academic subjects

Malaysia	<p>Year 12 in one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) (Malaysian Higher School Certificate Examination) with a minimum GPA of 2.0 for the best 4 principle subjects, including Bahasa Malaysia and General Knowledge Paper United Examination Certificate for Independent Chinese Secondary Schools (UEC) - at least 6 subjects with a score of B5 or better in at least 5 of these subjects, excluding Chinese Language or Bahasa Malaysia. GCE 'A' Levels with a minimum aggregate score of 6 in the best 3 A Level or combination of A and AS Level subjects, where A*=6, A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1 (AS Levels are equivalent to half points)
