Bangladesh	Higher Secondary Certificate with a CGPA of at least 4.0 or 70%
Brazil	<ul> <li>Certificado de Ensino Medio with minimum grade average of 8.0 (on a scale of 0-10)</li> </ul>
Hong Kong	<ul> <li>Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) with a minimum aggregate score of 15 over the best 5 subjects (across Core and category A or C electives), with a minimum grade requirement of 2 in each subject.</li> </ul>
India	<ul> <li>Year 12 in one of the following:</li> <li>All India Senior School Certificate (CBSE) with an average of at least 60%</li> <li>Indian School Certificate (ISCE) with an average of at least 60%</li> <li>Indian Higher Secondary School Certificate (State Board) with an average of at least 60%</li> <li>Certificate of Vocational Education with an average of at least 70%</li> </ul>
Indonesia	<ul> <li>Sekolah Menengah Atas (SMA) 3 with a minimum average score of 70% in the best 5 academic subjects</li> </ul>
Kenya	Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) with a mean grade of C+
Malaysia	<ul> <li>Year 12 in one of the following:</li> <li>Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) (Malaysian Higher School Certificate Examination) with a minimum GPA of 2.0 for the best 4 principle subjects, including Bahasa Malaysia and General Knowledge Paper</li> <li>United Examination Certificate for Independent Chinese Secondary Schools (UEC) - at least 6 subjects with a score of B5 or better in at least 5 of these subjects, excluding Chinese Language or Bahasa Malaysia.</li> <li>GCE 'A' Levels with a minimum aggregate score of 6 in the best 3 A Level or combination of A and AS Level subjects, where A*=6, A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1 (AS Levels are equivalent to half points)</li> </ul>
Nepal	<ul> <li>Nepalese Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) administered through:         <ul> <li>Higher Secondary Education Board (HESB) Year 12 with an average of at least 65%; OR</li> <li>National Examination Board (NEB) Year 12 with a GPA of at least 2.61 (i.e. 65%)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Pakistan	<ul> <li>Year 12 with an average of at least 65% in one of the following:         <ul> <li>Higher School Certificate; OR</li> <li>Intermediate Examination Certificate</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Philippines	<ul> <li>Senior High School Diploma K-12 Academic Track with an overall grade of at least 80% or higher</li> </ul>
