## BACHELOR OF SCREEN AND STAGE (ACTING)

### **Audition Requirements**



The application process for entry into the Bachelor of Screen and Stage (Acting) can be undertaken in three (3) different formats:



Face-to-face at our Brisbane campus




Live online via Zoom, or



Via submission of pre-recorded videos





- One (1) personal statement, maximum three minutes
- Two (2)
  monologues,
  maximum three
  minutes per piece



#### PERSONAL STATEMENT

Your personal statement is your chance to give us an insight into who you are and why you want to study at APAC. In preparing your personal statement you should consider the following questions, noting that there is no right or wrong answer and you don't have to answer all listed below:

- Who are you and where do you live?
- What are you currently doing? (Are you working, or at school? If at school, which one? etc)
- · What are your interests outside of acting?
- · What excites you?
- Why do you want to study acting at APAC?
- Is there anything else you would like us to know about you?

### **MONOLOGUES**

- Your monologues must be delivered in English, and each should be no more than three minutes in length. In choosing your monologues aim to demonstrate two (2) different characters. Prior to your audition, memorise and rehearse your monologues for performance.
- When deciding on your monologues, please choose from the list provided by APAC. See the <u>Acting Audition Information video</u> for more detailed information about choosing, rehearsing and if appropriate, videoing your monologues.



#### **AUDITION PREPARATION**

#### **FACE-TO-FACE**

To complete a FACE-TO-FACE audition, you will need to:



- Consider the questions listed in the Audition Content under Personal Statement to prepare talking points for your personal statement.
- Prepare, memorise and present your two (2) monologues.
- You will receive an invitation with your audition time and location.

#### **ONLINE AUDITION**

To complete a live audition ONLINE you will need:



- A quiet place in which to undertake the audition (deliver one (1) personal statement and two (2) contrasting monologues).
- Access to the internet.
- Mobile phone, tablet, laptop or desktop computer.
- Access to Zoom (you will receive an invitation with a zoom link and audition time).

#### PRE-RECORDED AUDITION

To complete a PRE-RECORDED audition, you will need:



- Access to video making technology (mobile phone and simple editing software is adequate)
- A quiet place in which to record your videos (one (1) personal statement and two (2) contrasting monologues)
- · Access to the internet to upload your videos to wetransfer.com
- You will receive a link to upload your files to.

# CREATING YOUR AUDITION VIDEOS

Set up your equipment checking your sound and lighting levels are satisfactory and that your camera angle and position is satisfactory.

Do not edit your videos. Your videoed monologues should run from start to finish without editing.

Each of the three (3) audition components should be presented as separate videos.

You do not need to use expensive specialist equipment to shoot your video. Your smartphone will do a more than adequate job. We need to be able to clearly see and hear you but please remember that it is your performance not the quality of your videoing and editing skills that we are interested in.
